

Distinguish, differentiate, compare and explain what is the Difference between Alveoli and Nephron. Comparison and Differences.

Difference between Alveoli and Nephron

Alveoli have thin-walled balloon-like structure. The alveoli provide a surface extensively supplied with blood capillaries for exchange of gases in lungs. Carbon dioxide released in the cavity of alveoli and oxygen is taken by hemoglobin present in RBC of blood.

Nephron is a cluster of very thin walled blood capillaries found in kidney. Each capillaries cluster remains associated with the cup-shaped end of a tube called Bowmans capsule that collects the filtered urine, at the same time the useful substance are reabsorbed.
