Difference between Biogas and Natural Gas

S.No.	Biogas	Natural Gas
1	It is formed by the decomposition of animal, plant and farm wastes.	It is a mixture of hydro-carbons and occurs frequently with petroleum.
2	Processed under controlled man made conditions.	Occurs naturally.
3	Biogas is mainly found in rural areas.	Natural Gas is mainly used in urban areas.
4	Used for domestic consumption n rural areas.	Primarily used in fertilizer industry.
5	Biogas is available in limited quantity.	Natural gas is available in large quantities.
6	Renewable resource.	Non-renewable resource.
7	Non-conventional source.	Conventional source.
