Distinguish, differentiate, compare and explain what is the Difference between Divorce and Annulment. Comparison and Differences.

Difference between Divorce and Annulment

- 1. Divorce can be predicated on a valid marriage. Annulment is predicated on an invalid marriage.
- 2. Divorce ends marriage as of the date of the divorce decree. Annulment ends a marriage retroactively to the date of the inception.
- 3. Grounds for divorce arise after the marriage. Grounds for annulment exist prior to the marriage, e.g. some impediment, such as incapacity.
- 4. Alimony is generally granted in a divorce action. Unless state statutes provide otherwise, alimony is not granted after issuance of the annulment decree.
