Differences between Drying and Dehydration

S.No.	Drying	Dehydration
1	Drying is a natural process.	Dehydration is a artificial process.
2	It does not have any control over climatic conditions.	It have a control over climatic conditions.
3	Dried product does not have good quality.	Dried product have good quality.
4	More space is required for drying.	Less space is required because it occurs within chamber.
5	Contamination from dust, insects & birds are major problem.	Sanitary conditions are controlled within a dehydration process.
6	It is less expensive.	It is more expensive.
