Distinguish, differentiate, compare and explain what is the Difference between Ionic and Covalent bond. Comparison and Differences.

Difference between Ionic and Covalent bond

- 1. An ionic bond is formed by transference of electrons from one atom to the other. A covalent bond is formed by the sharing of electron pairs by two atoms.
- 2. Ionic bonds are Electrostatic whereas Covalent bonds are not electrostatic, but they are rigid.
- 3. Ionic substances are formed by ionic bonds. Molecules are formed by a covalent bond.
- 4. An ionic bond is non-directional whereas Covalent bond is directional.
