Distinguish, differentiate, compare and explain what is the Difference between Moist Deciduous Forests and Dry Deciduous Forests. Comparison and Differences.

Difference between Moist and Dry Deciduous Forests

- 1. Moist Deciduous Forests are found in areas with annual rainfall between 100 and 200 cm. Dry Deciduous Forests are found in areas with annual rainfall between 70 and 100 cm.
- 2. In Moist Deciduous Forests, Teak, bamboo, sal, shisham, sandalwood, khair, kusum, arju n and mulberry trees are found. In Dry Deciduous Forests, Teak, sal, neem and peepal trees are found.
- 3. Not many of the Moist Deciduous Forests have been cleared. Large areas have been cleared for cultivation and grazing of Dry Deciduous Forests.
- 4. Moist Deciduous Forests cover about 34% of Indias forested area. Dry Deciduous Forests cover about 30% of Indias forested area.
