Difference between DOS and WINDOWS Operating System

1. Dos is a Single user operating system. Windows is a multi-user operating system.
2. In DOS, all commands are text based. In Windows, commands can be given by clicking on the icons.
3. Dos uses Command-line Interface. Windows used graphical user Interface.
4. Dos does not support networking. Windows support networking.
5. Server administration Is not possible in Dos. Server administration is possible in Windows.
6. While working in DOS, all the commands need to be remembered. In Windows, commands are readily available.
7. DOS can open only one window at a time. Multiple windows can be opened at a time in windows operating system.
