Difference between Exonuclease and Endonuclease

1. Exonuclease cuts DNA at ends. Endonuclease cleave DNA from between.
2. Exonuclease produces blunt ends. Endonuclease produces sticky ends.
3. Exonuclease is not restricting the entry of pathogen. Endonuclease restricts entry of pathogen.
