

Distinguish, differentiate, compare and explain what are the differences between Monocarpic Plants and Polycarpic Plant. Comparison and Differences.

## **Differences between Monocarpic Plants and Polycarpic Plant**

1. Monocarpic plants flower only once in their life. Polycarpic plants flower every year in particular season.
2. Monocarpic plants are generally annual or biennial. Very few monocarpic fruits are perennial. Polycarpic plants are perennial.
3. Monocarpic plants die after flowering and fruiting. Polycarpic plants do not die after flowering and fruiting.
4. Examples of Monocarpic plants are: Rice, Wheat, Radish, Carrot, Bamboo, etc. Examples of Polycarpic plants are : Apple, Mango, Grape wine, Orange, etc.
