Similarities between Archaea and Bacteria

- 1. Archaea have generally the same shape, size, and appearance as bacteria.
- 2. Like bacteria, Archaea multiply by binary fission and move primarily by means of flagella.
- 3. These morphological similarities can make it difficult to visually tell a bacterium and anarchaean apart.
- 4. Additionally, archaea are more phylo-genetically similar to eukarya than bacteriais to either of them.
