Differences between Mammals and Reptiles

S.No.	Mammals	Reptiles
1	Warm-blooded.	Cold-blooded.
2	Have hair on Fur.	Have scaly hair.
3	Give live birth.	Lay eggs.

Similarities between Mammals and Reptiles

- 1. Both are Vertebrates.
- 2. Both breath with lungs.

Some Special Features of Mammals are

- 1. They are warm-blooded
- 2. Have fur, hair or wool
- 3. They give birth to live young (the exception here is that platypus and echidna lay eggs)
- 4. The mother feeds milk to their young
- 5. They all have lungs

Some Special Features of Reptiles are

- 1. They are cold-blooded
- 2. Have hard leathery scales
- 3. Most have 4 limbs and a tail the (exception here is the snake has no limbs)
- 4. Most lay eggs with leathery shells
- 5. They have lungs
